

Park and Recreation Minutes

November 14, 2022

Chair Mike Carey called the meeting to order. Present were Mike Carey, Mark Page, Kacie Fahey, Nicole Bower, and Eric Hanson.

Dawn, Charlie or Jessica will be going through Holiday supplies in the next couple of weeks. There will be no Mrs. Claus this year. Dawn will try to verify youth craft volunteers with Hope Church this week. Set-up will be on Wednesday, November 30th at 6:00 PM. The Holiday Party will be Saturday, December 3rd from 10AM – Noon.

The Town Board will set the rates for Stelzel Fields when they have a hearing on the fee schedule ordinance. This hearing is likely to take place on the last week of December. Mike has left an edited copy of the proposed Stelzel Field contract for 2023, with minor corrections.

The next Park & Rec. Meeting will be moved to Wednesday, November 30th. In December, we will only meet on Monday, December 12th. Meeting frequency for January through March will be evaluated at that time.

At the December 12th meeting, Park & Rec. will discuss trash and light fees at Stelzel Fields and will make recommendations to the Board, following that discussion.

Dawn has continued to coordinate with food truck vendors for the spring event with six food trucks currently confirmed.

The remainder of the Town Hall Park grant was received, and Charlie will schedule a meeting in the Spring with the Grant Coordinator for project closeout. Maintenance will put up the birdhouses and Charlie and Dawn will order signs for the plants.
